SOLO's latest round of Outlook documents is now available...







News from the WHEATWATCHER project

From soil sensing to smarter farming – watch the concept video

The Horizon Europe project **WHEATWATCHER** is developing an integrated system of advanced soil and crop monitoring tools, designed to support sustainable wheat production and food safety across Europe.

In its newly released **concept video**, the project presents how a combination of **stationary**, **mobile and remote sensing platforms**, together with **Al-powered analysis and cloud-based tools**, enables farmers to monitor soil and crop health in real-time. These insights are delivered through a user-friendly **Decision Support System (DSS)**, helping optimise input use, reduce contamination risks, and strengthen traceability along the grain value chain.
